Upon motion by Tom Richter, seconded by Melvin McLawhorn, the Transportation Advisory Committee of the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization voted to adopt the following resolution:

RESOLUTION

ADOPTING LOCAL INPUT POINT ASSIGNMENTS FOR PRIORITIZATION 7.0 PROJECTS COMPETING IN THE DIVISION NEEDS FUNDING CATEGORY

WHEREAS, the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization provides cooperative, comprehensive, and continuing transportation planning services for Beaufort County, Martin County, and the areas of Pitt County not within a Metropolitan Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Transportation Advisory Committee is the duly recognized transportation planning policy board for the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Transportation Investments Law, passed by the North Carolina General Assembly in 2013, establishes the Strategic Mobility Formula; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Mobility Formula uses quantitative data and local input to determine which transportation projects will be prioritized for inclusion in the State Transportation Improvement Program; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Transportation Investments Law establishes the Statewide Mobility, Regional Impact, and Division Needs funding categories for projects; and

WHEREAS, the final scores for projects competing in the Statewide Mobility funding category are 100% quantitative data; and

WHEREAS, the final scores for projects competing in the Regional Impact funding category are 70% quantitative data, 15% Division Local Input, and 15% Planning Organization Local Input; and

WHEREAS, the final scores for projects competing in the Division Needs funding category are 50% quantitative data, 25% Division Local Input, and 25% Planning Organization Local Input; and

WHEREAS, the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization, in accordance with the Strategic Transportation Investments Law, has developed and adopted a Local Input Point Assignment Methodology as a guide in assigning local input points for projects competing in the Regional Impact and Division Needs funding categories in Prioritization 7.0; and

WHEREAS, Mid-East Rural Planning Organization staff has received the quantitative scores for projects competing in the Division Needs funding category, and has developed draft local input point assignments, in accordance with the adopted Local Input Point Assignment Methodology.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: that the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization Transportation Advisory Committee hereby adopts the Mid-East Rural Planning Organization's Local Input Point assignments for projects competing in the Division Needs category in Prioritization 7.0.
